


Figure 28: Required Drinking Fountains and Configurements

Section 412.2 - Floor drains




Figure 29: Floor Drains Do Not Have Ready Access

Floor drains must have ready access. An exception is added to allow floor drains serving refrigerated display cases to only require access to the floor drain (see Figure 29).
